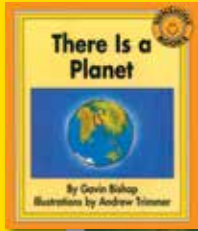

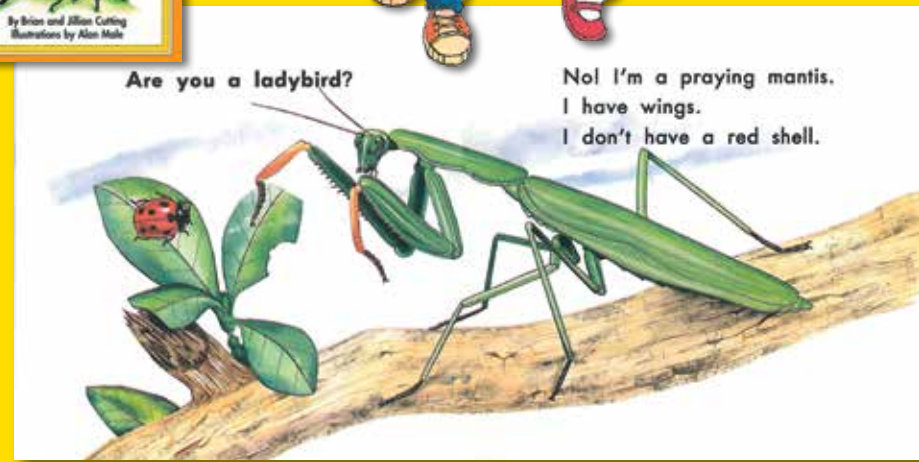
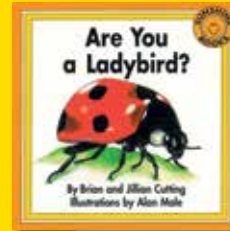

there is a town.

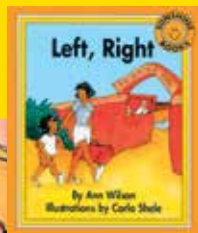


And in that town,
there is a street.



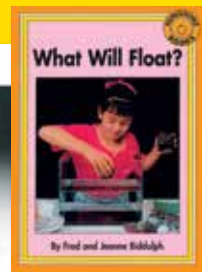
Are you a ladybird?

It is heavy for its size.

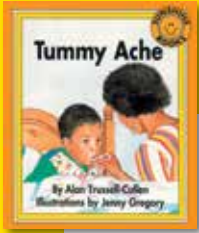


Here is an apple with holes in it.
Will it float?

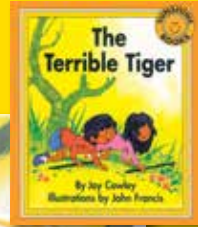


Here is a potato with holes in it.
Will it sink?



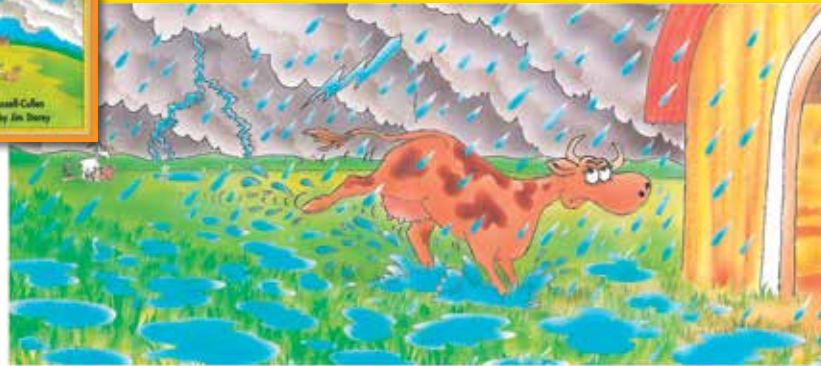


Here comes the doctor!

is feeling worse!



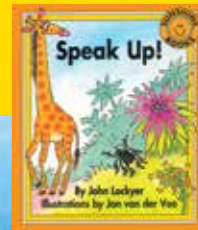
Creep, creep through the forest.
